REQUESTED VARIANCE:

The applicant is requesting a variance to allow for the installation of a free standing main sign that is 150 square feet per sign face and 25 feet in height, exceeding the sign standards allowed within the Englewood Overlay District.

RELEVANT AUTHORITY:

Land Development Code of Escambia County, Florida (Ordinance No. 96-3 as amended), Section: 6.07.04. Englewood Overlay District

- I. Non-residential site and building requirements.
- 6. Signs.
- c. Free-standing on-premises signs shall be "human scaled". There shall be only one such sign per parcel and it shall not exceed 100 square feet per sign face and 12 feet in height;

CRITERIA

Land Development Code of Escambia County, Florida (Ordinance No. 96-3 as amended), Section 2.05.02. Variances.

CRITERION (1)

That there are special circumstances or conditions applicable to the building or land in question that are peculiar to such property that do not apply generally to other land or buildings in the vicinity.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

Section 2.05.02 of the Land Development Code defines special circumstances or conditions specifically as follows: "Such special conditions shall be limited to unusual physical characteristics inherent in the specific piece of property and not common to properties similarly situated. Such physical characteristics include, but are not limited to, exceptional narrowness,

shallowness, shape, topographic conditions, or the presence of sensitive environmental resources, any or all of which will result in peculiar or practical difficulties in the quiet enjoyment and use of the property".

The parcel can be accessed via W Street from the West and from Fairfield on the North. This is a corner lot on a busy intersection. The property is located within the boundaries of the Englewood Redevelopment Area, resulting in more specific requirements for development within the parcel. The site location does present unique physical characteristics that impose practical difficulties as the frontage and lateral shape of the parcel is at an angle not parallel to Fairfield; as a result, the main building is located farther back from the street. The applicant states that the setback from the right of way (ROW) combined with other existing physical elements, such as a public transportation stop, would impede motorist from safely accessing their business.

CRITERION (2)

That the variance is necessary for the preservation and enjoyment of a substantial property right and not merely to serve as a convenience to the Applicant.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

This is a commercially zoned property and the proposed business would depend on the revenue received from attracting travelers into their facility. The proper visualization of advertisement could be considered a substantial property right for this type of zoning.

CRITERION (3)

That such a variance will not impair an adequate supply of light and air to adjacent property or unreasonably increase the congestion in public streets, the danger of fire, imperil the public safety, unreasonably diminish or impair established property values within the surrounding area or in any other respect impair the health, safety, comfort, or general welfare of the inhabitants of Escambia County.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

This variance will not impair an adequate supply of light and air to adjacent property or unreasonably increase the congestion in public streets, the danger of fire, imperil the public safety, unreasonably diminish or impair established property values within the surrounding area, or in any other respect impair the health, safety, comfort, or general welfare of the inhabitants of Escambia County.

CRITERION (4)

The variance will not, in any manner, alter other provisions of this Code or Comprehensive Plan.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

This variance will not alter other provisions of the Land Development Code or Comprehensive Plan.

CRITERION (5)

That the variance is the minimum necessary to make possible the use of the land, building or other improvements as approved by the BOA.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

As stated above, based on the existing unique physical characteristics, the applicant's variance, as requested, would be the minimum necessary to make possible the use of the land.

To whom it may concern:

RaceTrac Petroleum has filed a variance appeal with Escambia County for a 1.81 acre assemblage located at 2741 W Fairfield Drive. The variance request is to allow use of a 150 SF, 25' tall, main sign as allowed in the general code section 8.07.03 instead of a 100 SF, 12' tall, monument sign allowed as part of the Englewood Overlay District in section 6.04.07.

RaceTrac is requesting this hardship variance to improve visibility of the main price sign for passing motorist. Due to utility lines, a County bus shelter, neighboring trees, and changes in topography, it would be difficult for passing motorist to see our main monument sign in time to make a safe turning maneuver onto W or V Street. The shape of the site also pushes the building and canopy further away from Fairfield Drive then would normally be allowed making visibility of the site difficult for eastbound motorist. Our goal is to place the sign and a new bus stop pad for the County so that visibility of the sign is maximized and access to the bus shelter is improved.

RaceTrac would strongly encourage the Board to approve our variance based on the benefits to motorist reaction time and that the sign will not have a negative affect the overall aesthetic of the site.

This variance will not impair an adequate supply of light and air to adjacent property or unreasonably increase the congestion in public streets, the danger of fire, imperil the public safety, unreasonably diminish or impair established property values within the surrounding area, or in any other respect impair the health, safety, comfort, or general welfare of the inhabitants of Escambia County.

CRITERION (4)

The variance will not, in any manner, alter other provisions of this Code or Comprehensive Plan.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

This variance will not alter other provisions of the Land Development Code or Comprehensive Plan.

CRITERION (5)

That the variance is the minimum necessary to make possible the use of the land, building or other improvements as approved by the BOA.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

Based on review of the application submitted by the owners and staff's site visit, the requested

variance would be the minimum necessary to make possible the improvements, as requested by the applicant.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the variance as requested.

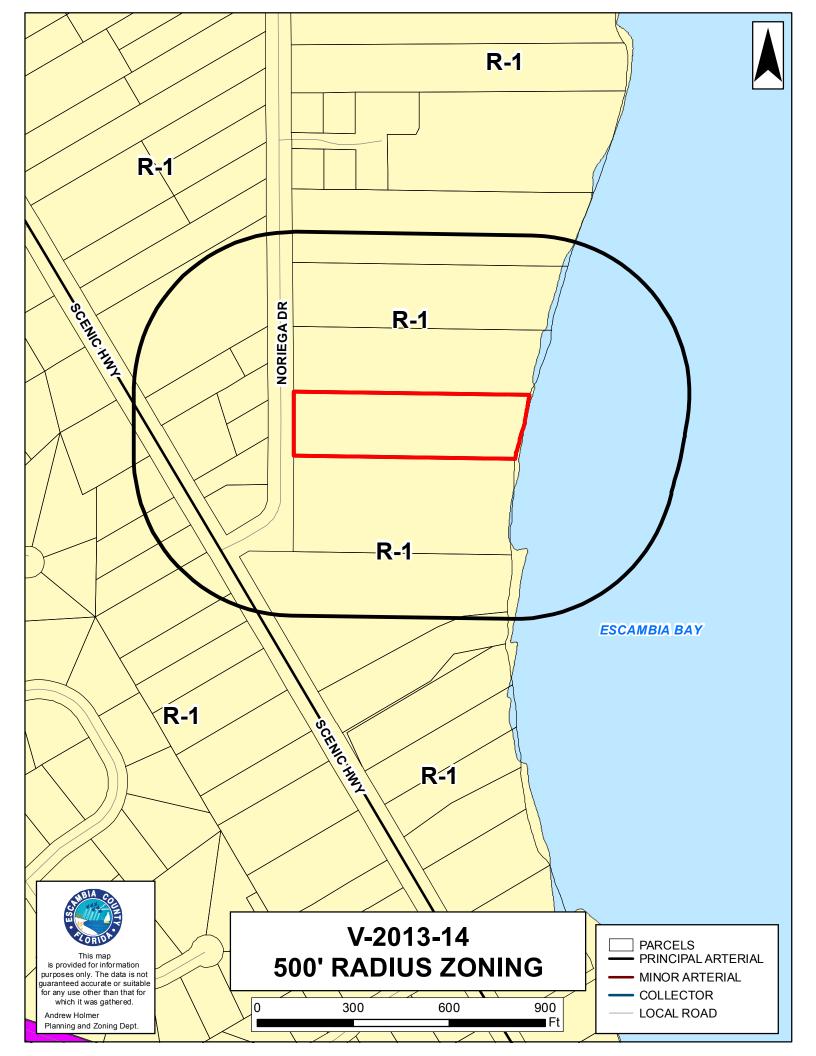

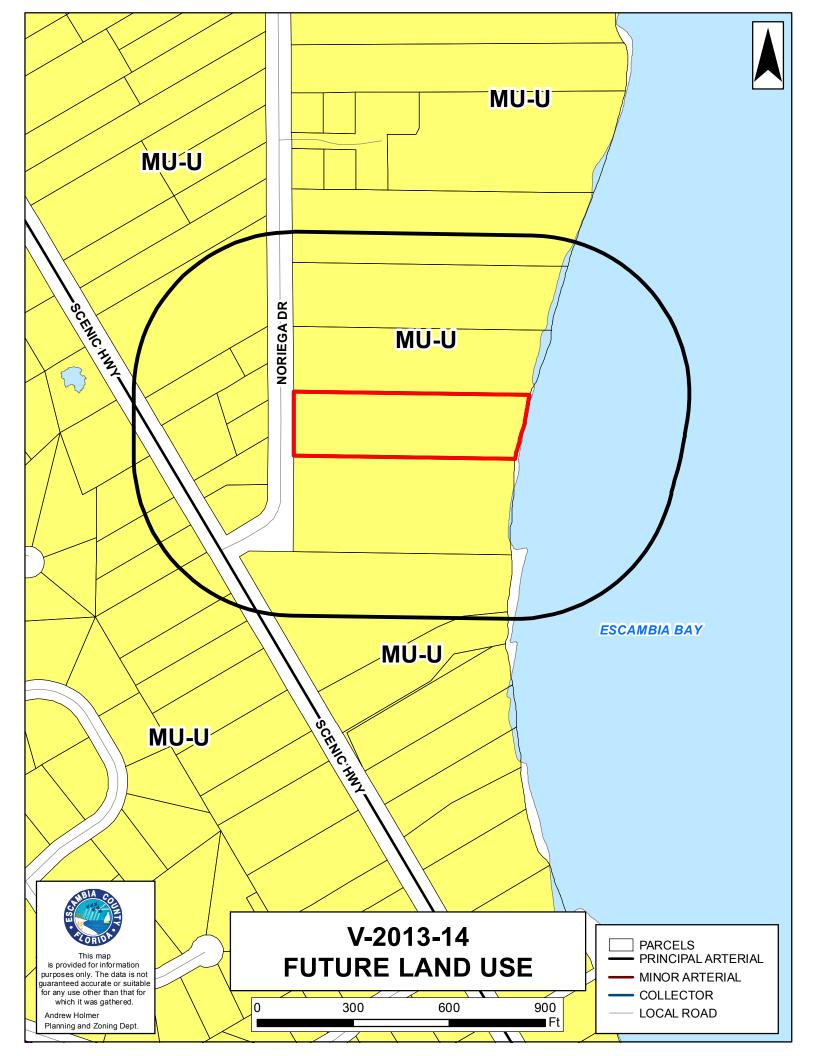

Dear Sir or Madam,

We are requesting your consideration for granting a variance to the Escambia County Land Development Code. We wish to rebuild, on the exact same concrete slab, a building that was crushed in Hurricane Ivan. Financial circumstances have prevented us from pursuing this until now. With finances improving, we wish to replace the building with a mother-in-law suite/guest residence to accommodate our sick and aging parents.

An initial review of the enclosed conceptual drawing was done by the Development Services Department. The following problem was identified: the structure that was destroyed was a fully enclosed workshop, and we wish to replace it with a dwelling, as noted above. Because of this change, the footprint of the building was felt to be too close to the neighbors' property. Unfortunately, we have no other suitable land upon which to locate the structure (as outlined in Criterion 1).

We have obtained full consent of our neighbors to proceed with the construction of a guest residence on the site where the destroyed building stood, as documented in the notarized letter included.

We respectfully request that you review our application for a variance so that we may proceed with replacing this building that was lost in Hurricane Ivan.

Criterion 1) The location upon which we wish to rebuild is required by the unique topography of our property. We have a very steep drop-off on the east side of our home. The bulk of our property is located there, but the depth of the drop-off would make construction extremely difficult and result in a dwelling that was flood-prone. Trying to build on the west side of our home, which is our front yard, would violate Article 6.03.01. E because our property is waterfront. Therefore, placing a guest residence there is prohibited. To the south of our home is a paved driveway that is our access to the waterfront. The only remaining location on the property for building would be to the north of our home, where the building that was destroyed previously stood. This is where we wish to rebuild.

Criterion 2) Regarding the preservation of a "substantial property right," we need the use of the site in order to house aging parents (with no other local relatives) that we will soon be caring for. Our father/father-in-law has cancer with an uncertain prognosis. Our mother/ mother-in-law will be physically unable to care for him as his health deteriorates. They currently live in rural Walton County and have had burglaries on their property. Should our father/ father-in-law die, our mother/mother-in-law will be unsafe in the isolated home they currently inhabit. They have no other relatives in Florida and need to move in with us, but our home does not have a spare bedroom and is not wheelchair accessible. Hence, our request to rebuild our workshop as a mother-in-law suite is submitted for your consideration.

Criterion 3) As evidenced by the enclosed photographs, the location of the proposed building is far away from our neighbor's driveway and even farther away from their home, avoiding any health, lighting, or safety issues. Placing a tastefully designed dwelling (drawings enclosed) on the existing concrete slab (an eyesore) will enhance my property value and that of my neighbor.

Criterion 4) The proposed variance does not, to our knowledge, conflict with any other provision of the Code. If we were to move the proposed structure away from the property line and closer to my home, it would have to be either so small as to barely suffice for a dwelling, or it would violate the requirement for adequate distance between dwellings. Please see Article 2.10.01.C enclosed.

Criterion 5) The proposed variance is the smallest adjustment to the Code we can conceive that allows for an adequately-sized dwelling, located on the only site on our property that will not cause other violations. As previously noted, we have the full consent of the neighbor sharing the property line in question. See enclosed notarized letter.

Article 6 ZONING DISTRICTS

- 2. Mechanical equipment impact. Use, in connection with the home occupation, of any mechanical or electrical equipment which creates interference or causes adverse impacts on adjoining or nearby properties is prohibited. Those devices normally used in agricultural activities, for household purposes, or for other domestic purposes are not regulated by this section. (The use of personal computers, typewriters, calculators, etc., is not regulated by this Code);
- 3. External structural alterations. External structural alterations not customarily associated with residential buildings are prohibited;
- 4. Noise or similar impacts. Offensive noise, vibration, smoke, dust, or other particulate matter, odorous matter, heat, glare or other objectionable effects are prohibited;
- 5. *Employees*. Employment of persons other than a family member residing in the dwelling unit, is prohibited unless otherwise approved as part of a conditional use permit pursuant to section 2.05.00 of this Code:
- 6. Customers. No customers shall visit the house nor shall there be any other additional traffic or an increase in demand for parking due to trucks or other service vehicles coming to the house;
- 7. *Group instruction or assembly.* Group instruction or assembly; fortune telling; massage parlors, modeling studios, photography studios and similar services are prohibited;
- 8. Mobile homes. A home occupation or commercial activity is prohibited in a residential mobile home; and
- 9. Auto repair. The manufacturer or repair of motor vehicles or other transportation equipment is prohibited.
- C. Residential occupancy. If occupancy/residential use is customarily associated with and appropriately incidental to a principal nonresidential activity on the same lot.
- D. *Employee/visitor support*. Support services and functions/activities normally associated with the permitted principal use including, but not limited to, cafeterias, lunch/break rooms, health or fitness facilities.

- E. Accessory structures. Accessory structures to a residence (excluding agricultural zoning and farms) shall not exceed 50 percent of the size of the primary structure or 500 square feet, whichever is larger, for parcels up to two acres in size. Parcels of two to five acres in size may have accessory structures up to 75 percent of the size of the primary structure and parcels greater than five acres may have accessory structures up to 100 percent of the size of the primary structure. Structures larger than the above allowed sizes shall require conditional use approval from the BOA. Accessory buildings or guest residences on waterfront lots shall require conditional use approval from the BOA to locate in a front yard of the principle dwelling and shall not be located within 60 feet of a front property line. If the parcel is zoned commercial, the accessory structure may be larger than the above standard but in such case, it shall require site plan approval as a commercial structure in accordance with article 4, part II.
- F. Docks, piers and mooring devices. Noncommercial structures such as piers, docks, wharves, mooring devices, lifting and launching devices are permitted as accessory structures where allowed in residential districts.

The regulations set forth in this section modify, adjust or supplement the district regulations appearing in article 6 of this Code.

2.10.01. General modifications.

- A. Yard encroachment including roof overhang. Every part of a required yard shall be open from its lowest point to the sky unobstructed, except for the ordinary projection of sills, belt courses, cornices, buttresses, awnings, eaves and similar features approved by the county BOA. None of the above projections shall project into any yard more than 24 inches, except roof overhangs and awnings which may extend 48 inches into any yard provided the respective yard is at least ten feet in depth. In no case shall a structure project into a public right-of-way without prior approval by the BCC.
- B. *Projecting fire escapes, stairways, balconies, chimneys or flues*. Open or enclosed fire escapes, outside stairways and balconies projecting into a minimum yard not more than 3 1/2 feet and the ordinary projections of chimneys and flues may be permitted by the building official where the same do not obstruct light and ventilation.



- C. Distance between buildings on same lot. As specified in the zoning district regulations, more than one dwelling may be located upon a lot provided that the horizontal open space between such buildings measured at the closest point shall not be less than twice the side yard required in the district in which such uses are located.
- D. Use of lots less than required size. Any lot of record as of February 8, 1996, that contains less land area depth or width than is required in the district in which such lot is located, may be used for the uses permitted in such district.
- E. Sanitary waste disposal. Whenever a lot is not served by an approved sewer, there must be provided such open space as required by F.A.C. ch. 10-D(6) (septic tank regulations) of the Florida Administrative Code and as administered by the Escambia County Health Unit for septic tanks with flows of up to 5,000 gallons per day and drainage field to serve the uses erected on such lot. Such sanitary installation may be located in a front, side or rear yard but not closer than five feet to any lot line.

Such physical characteristics include, but are not limited to, exceptional narrowness, shallowness, shape, topographic conditions, or the presence of sensitive environmental resources, any or all of which will result in peculiar or practical difficulties in the quiet enjoyment and use of the property".

The applicant's parcel has unique physical attributes for the area, being the narrowest of the four waterfront lots in this platted subdivision. In addition, the east side of the property borders a condominium tower with adjoining patio.

The unique characteristics of this site present practical difficulties for building a residence in the similar manner as others in the subdivision.

CRITERION (2)

That the variance is necessary for the preservation and enjoyment of a substantial property right and not merely to serve as a convenience to the Applicant.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

The requested variance is necessary for the preservation and enjoyment of a substantial property right.

CRITERION (3)

That such a variance will not impair an adequate supply of light and air to adjacent property or unreasonably increase the congestion in public streets, the danger of fire, imperil the public safety, unreasonably diminish or impair established property values within the surrounding area or in any other respect impair the health, safety, comfort, or general welfare of the inhabitants of Escambia County.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

This variance will not impair an adequate supply of light and air to adjacent property or unreasonably increase the congestion in public streets, the danger of fire, imperil the public safety, unreasonably diminish or impair established property values within the surrounding area, or in any other respect impair the health, safety, comfort, or general welfare of the inhabitants of Escambia County.

CRITERION (4)

The variance will not, in any manner, alter other provisions of this Code or Comprehensive Plan.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

This variance will not alter other provisions of the Land Development Code or Comprehensive Plan.

CRITERION (5)

That the variance is the minimum necessary to make possible the use of the land, building or other improvements as approved by the BOA.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

Given the unique physical characteristics of this site, the requested variance is the minimum necessary to use the site in a similar manner as other properties in the subdivision.

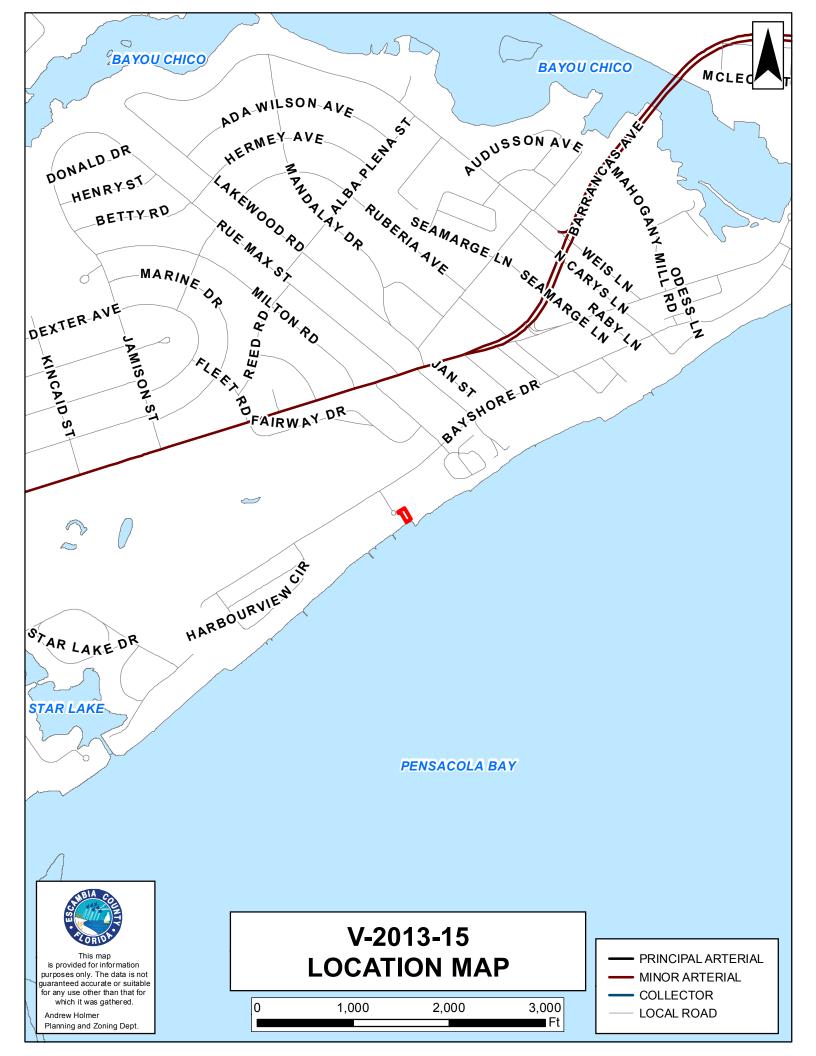

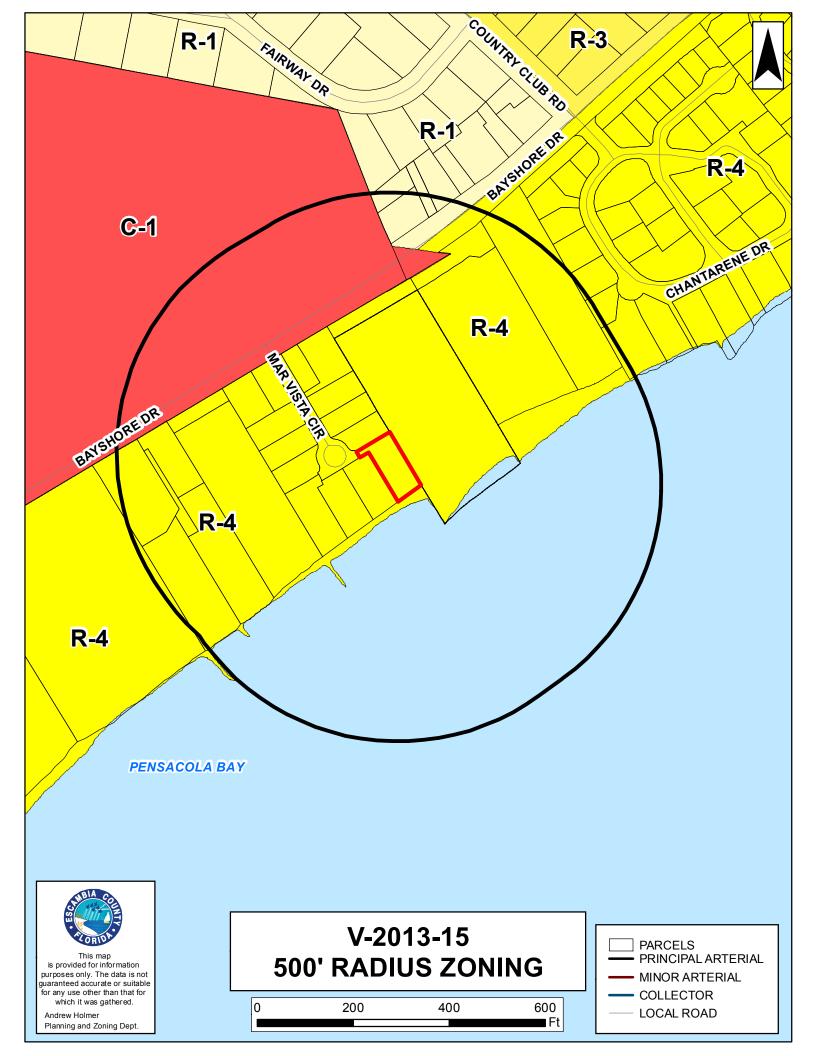

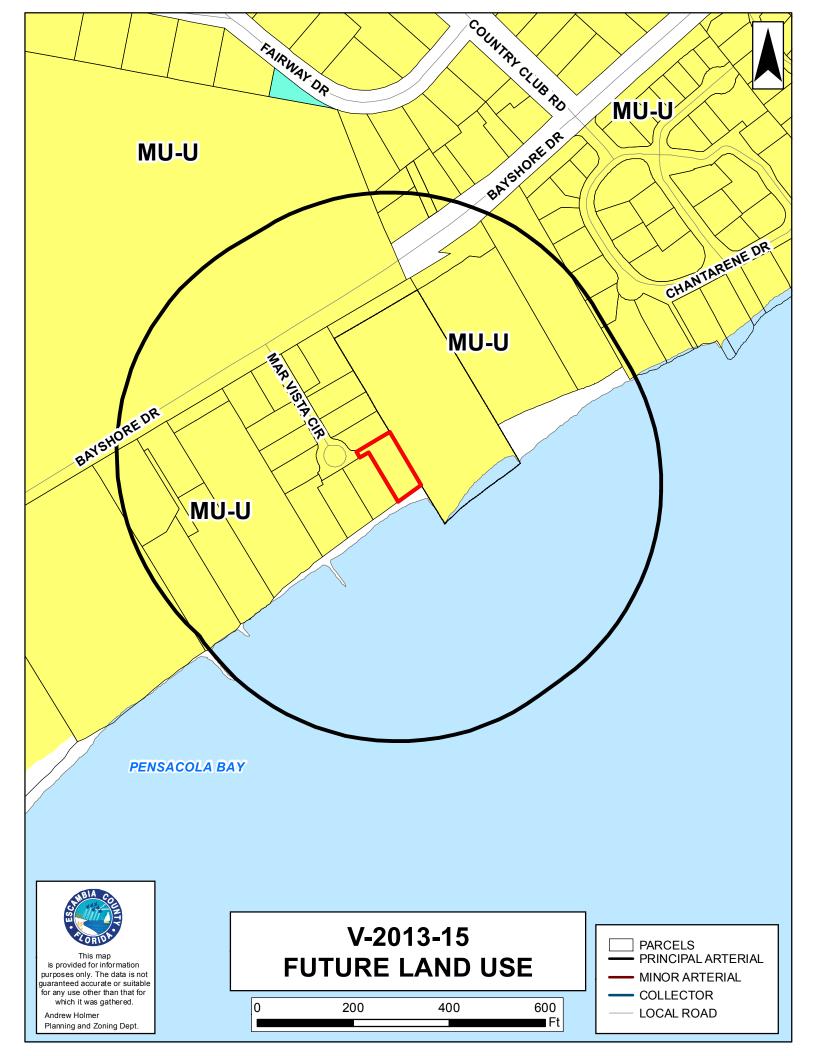

The Request is based on several factors that are Limiting the Full Use and Enjoyment of the Property :

-The waterfront Lots in this Subdivision are longitudinal in layout.

Lot 6 is up to 20% narrower than any other waterfront Lot as well as much smaller overall due to the curvature of the shoreline and this makes it unique compared to the other Lots. -The Lot is only 55 ft. wide by 114ft. long and is located on the far Eastern side of the Subdivision that borders a large Condo Bldg. (Bayshore Condo) -the adjacent waterfront Lots are significantly Wider and Longer that allows the homes to be wider and not look abnormally narrow on the interior:

Two of the Lots are approx. 65 ft. wide and the other is 61 ft. wide and this allows the homes to be more "normal" in interior dimension, Whereas this Lot 6 narrowness forces the interior dimension to be very narrow and look almost like a "trailer" room inside and limiting the comparable use and enjoyment of the property compared to others there.

-The other Unique consideration is that the East side of the Lot borders a Large Condo next door.

Proposed Dollar General Store 4940 Saufley Field Road Pensacola, Florida

1. On-site circulation. Ingress and egress to property and proposed structures thereon with particular reference to automotive and pedestrian safety and convenience, traffic flow and control, on-site parking and loading, and access in case of fire or catastrophe.

RESPONSE: As shown on the attached preliminary site plan, access will be available through two separate entrance/exit points resulting in a "horseshoe" configuration with two way traffic flow. The small, compact size of the proposed store will provide convenient and safety to the residents. No street parking is allowed which will facilitate emergency access.

2. Nuisance. Any adverse impact such as noise, glare, smoke, odor or other harmful effects (electrical interference, hazardous materials, etc.) of the conditional use on adjoining properties and properties generally in the District.

RESPONSE: This store will be similar in appearance to other commercial buildings located along Saufley Field Road and operation will not produce adverse impacts to any adjoining properties.

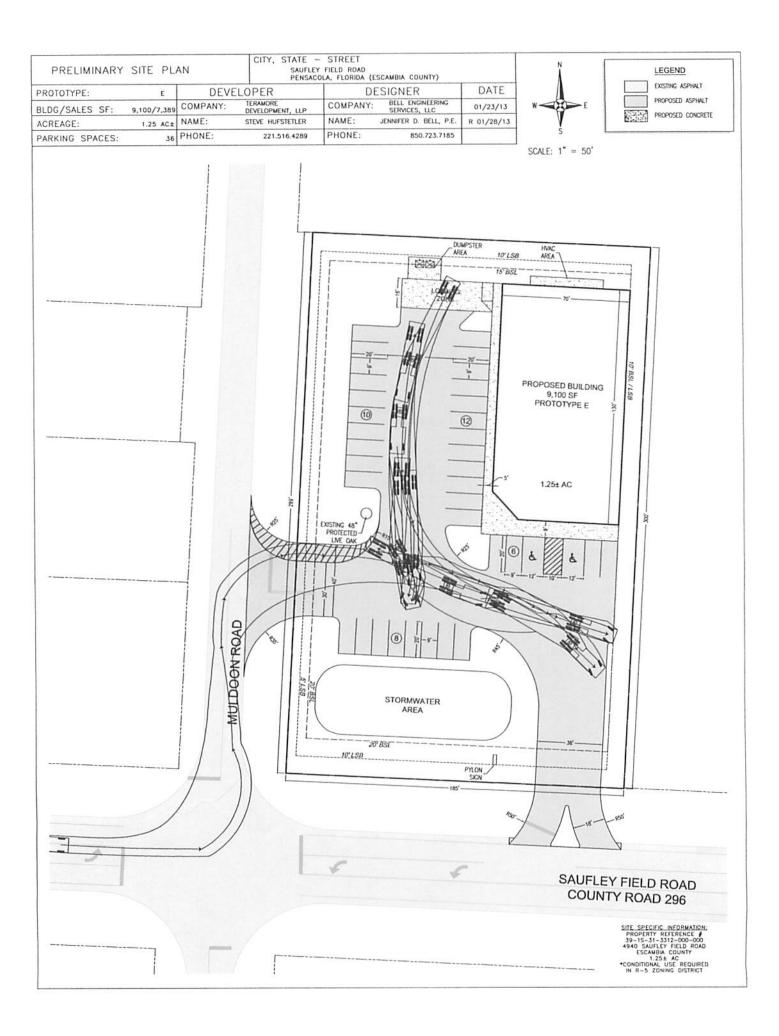

The applicant is requesting Conditional Use approval to construct an accessory structure over 50% of the size of the primary structure. The primary structure on site is 3287 square feet and the proposed accessory structure is 2000 square feet.

RELEVANT AUTHORITY:

Land Development Code of Escambia County, Florida (Ordinance 96-3 as amended), Section:6.03.01.E

E. Accessory structures. Accessory structures to a residence (excluding agricultural zoning and farms) shall not exceed 50 percent of the size of the primary structure or 500 square feet, whichever is larger, for parcels up to two acres in size.

CRITERIA:

Land Development Code of Escambia County, Florida (Ordinance 96-3 as amended), Section 2.05.03

CRITERION (1)

On-site circulation. Ingress and egress to property and proposed structures thereon with particular reference to automotive and pedestrian safety and convenience, traffic flow and control, on-site parking and loading, and access in case of fire or catastrophe.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

The site will be accessed by internal driveways connecting to Pine Forest Rd.

CRITERION (2)

Nuisance. Adverse impact such as noise, glare, smoke, odor or other harmful effects (electrical interference, hazardous materials, etc.) of the conditional use on adjoining properties and properties generally in the District.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

Staff finds no anticipated adverse impacts associated with the proposed structure.

CRITERION (3)

Solid Waste. Refuse and service areas with particular reference to concurrency requirements and items (1) and (2) above.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

Solid waste service should be provided in the same manner as the primary structure.

CRITERION (4)

Utilities. Utilities with reference to concurrency requirements, location, availability and compatibility with surrounding land uses.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

Any needed utilities will need to be provided by the applicant.

CRITERION (5)

Buffers. The buffer may be a landscaped natural barrier, a natural barrier or a landscaped or natural barrier supplemented with fencing or other man-made barriers, so long as the function of the buffer and the intent of Policy FLU 1.1.9 of the Comprehensive Plan and the provisions of Section 7.01.06 of the Land Development Code are fulfilled.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

No buffering will be required with the proposed use.

CRITERION (6)

Signs. Signs, if any, and proposed exterior lighting with reference to glare, traffic safety, economic effect, and compatibility and harmony with properties in the District.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

No signage is proposed by the applicant.

CRITERION (7)

Environment impact. Impacts to protected trees, wetlands, water bodies, stormwater management or other natural features of the subject parcel.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

There are no anticipated environmental impacts from the proposed structure.

CRITERION (8)

Neighborhood impact. General compatibility with adjacent properties and other property in the immediate area.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

The proposed structure should be compatible with the surrounding area.

CRITERION (9)

Other requirements of Code. The proposed Conditional Use is consistent with all other relevant provisions of this Code.

FINDINGS-OF-FACT

The proposed Conditional Use is consistent with all other relevant provisions of this Code.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff finds that the proposed use meets all of the required criteria and approval is recommended.

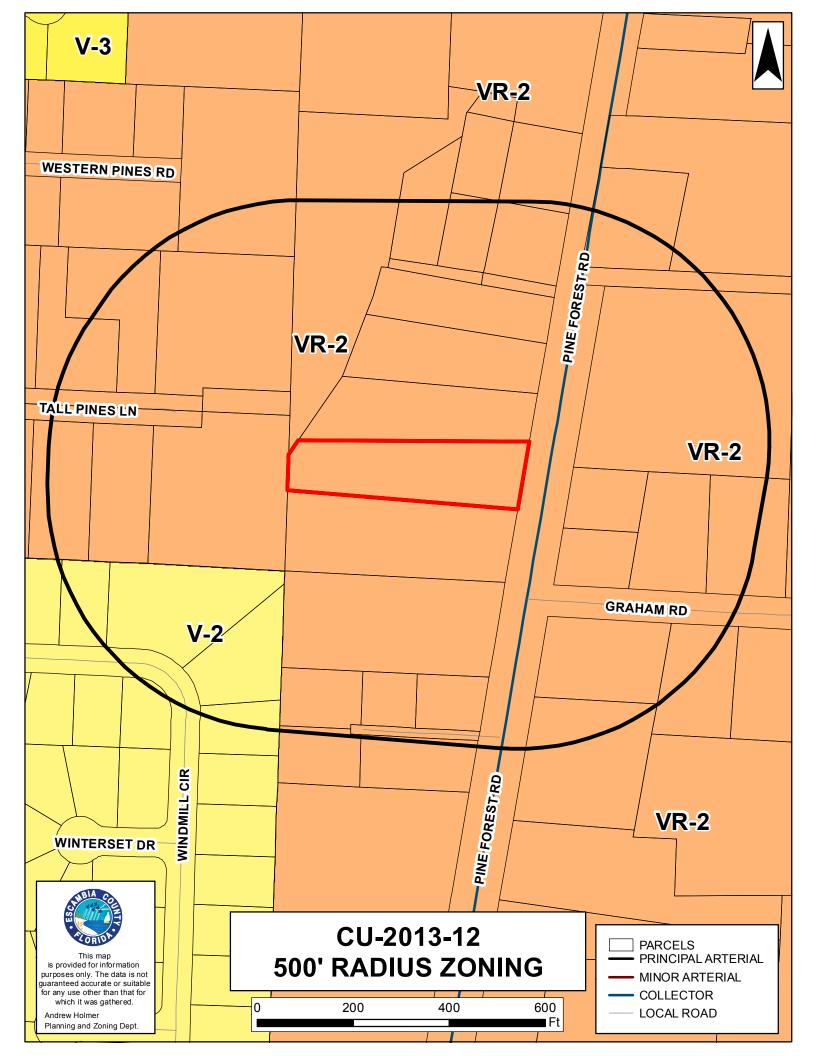

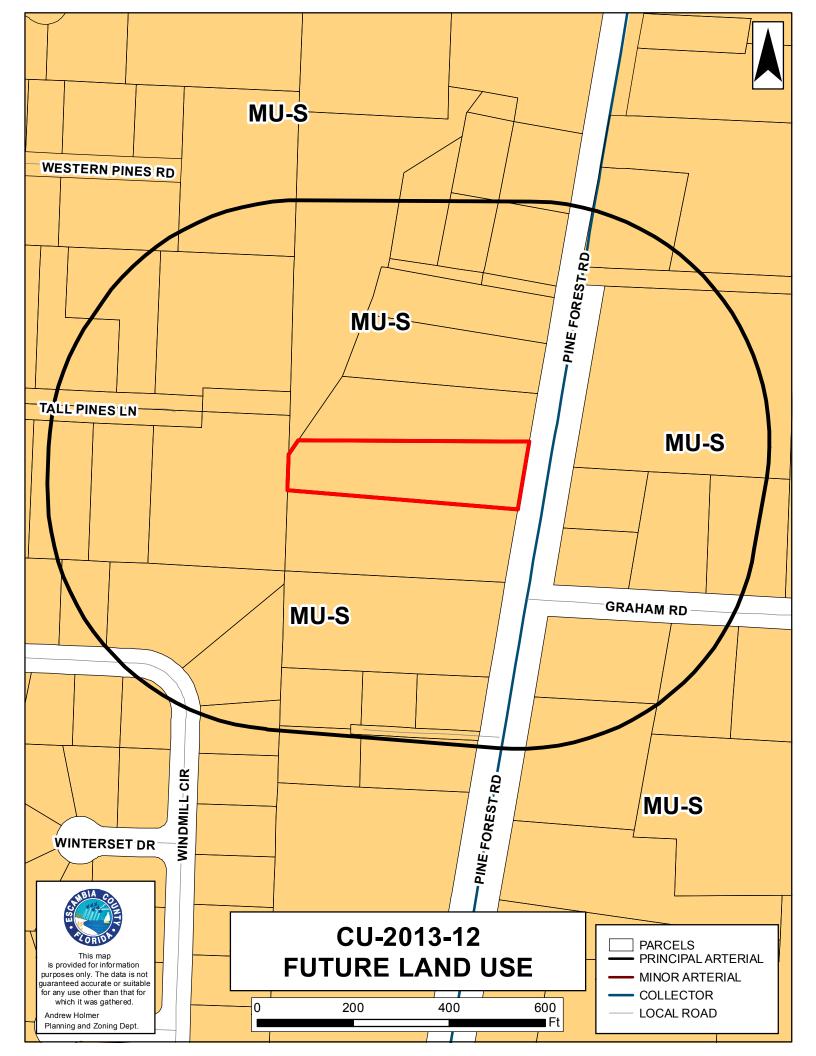

DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY OF RICHARD M. VAN GEE

BY THIS DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY, I, RICHARD M. VAN GEE, Soc. Sec. No. 071-18-1018, of 2997 Pine Forest Road, Cantonment, FL 32533, revoke any and all prior grants of a Durable Power of Attorney and appoint my daughter, CLAUDIA VAN GEE (the "Attorney-in-Fact"), to act for me and in my name in any and all business, financial, legal, and other matters, granting full authority to make, acknowledge, and deliver for me and in my name all contracts, deeds, leases, assignments, writings, assurances, releases, and other instruments that my Attorney-in-Fact may deem proper in connection with any matter in which I may be interested, and generally to act for me and in my name in all matters affecting my business or property. real or personal, with the same effect as though I were personally present and acting for myself.

THIS DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY (THE "POWER") SHALL NOT BE AFFECTED BY ANY PHYSICAL OR MENTAL DISABILITY THAT I MAY SUFFER EXCEPT AS PROVIDED BY STATUTE, AND SHALL BE EXERCISABLE IMMEDIATELY FROM THIS DATE WITHOUT ANY OTHER ACTION OR CONDITION WHATSOEVER. This Power shall not be affected by a lapse of time between its grant and its exercise. All acts done by my Attorney-in-Fact pursuant to this Power, including acts taken during any period of my disability or incompetence, shall inure to the benefit of and bind me, my heirs, devisees and personal representatives, as if I were competent and not disabled. This Power is non-delegable and shall be valid until such time I die, revoke the Power, or be judged incompetent.

At any time a petition to determine my competency or a petition to appoint a guardian for me is filed, this Power shall be temporarily suspended. Notice of the pending petition shall be given to all known donees of this Power in line with F.S. 709.08(2). This Power shall remain suspended until the petition is dismissed or withdrawn, or I am adjudged competent, at which time the Power shall be automatically reinstated and any exercise of the Power shall be valid. If I am adjudged incompetent, the Power shall be automatically revoked.

Whenever an emergency arises between the time a petition is filed and an adjudication is made regarding my competency, the donee of this Power may petition the court for permission to exercise the Power. The petition shall specify the emergency, the property involved, and the proposed action of the donee. No exercise of the Power by the donee during the time a petition is pending shall be valid without the permission of the court.

All of my real and personal property and interests in such property are subject to this Power.

Without limiting the broad powers conferred by the preceding provisions, I authorize my Attorney-in-Fact to:

- 1. <u>COLLECT MONEY AND OTHER PROPERTY</u>. Collect all sums of money and other property that may be payable or belonging to me, and to execute receipts, releases, cancellations or discharges relating thereto.
- 2. <u>SETTLE ACCOUNTS</u>. Settle any account in which I may have any interest and to pay or receive the balance of that account as the case may be.
- 3. <u>ENTER SAFE DEPOSIT BOX</u>. Enter any safe deposit box or other place of safekeeping standing in my name alone or jointly with another and to remove the contents and to make additions, substitutions and replacements.
- 4. <u>BORROW MONEY</u>. Borrow money on such terms, and with such security as my Attorney-in-Fact may think fit and to execute all notes, mortgages and other instruments that my Attorney-in-Fact finds necessary or desirable.
- 5. <u>DEAL WITH COMMERCIAL INSTRUMENTS</u>. Draw, accept, endorse or otherwise deal with any check or any other commercial or mercantile instrument, specifically including the right to make deposits or withdrawals from any saving account, checking account, money market account or similar accounts.
- 6. <u>REDEEM BONDS</u>. Redeem bonds issued by the United States Government or any of its agencies, any other bonds and any certificates of deposit or other similar assets belonging to me.
- 7. <u>SELL PERSONAL PROPERTY</u>. Sell bonds, shares of stock, warrants, debentures, or other items of tangible or intangible personal property belonging to me, and execute all assignments and other instruments necessary or proper for transferring them to the purchaser or purchasers, and give good receipts and discharges for all money payable in respect to them.
- 8. <u>INVEST PROCEEDS</u>. Invest the proceeds of any redemptions or sales and any other money, in bonds, shares of stock and other securities as my Attorney-in-Fact shall think fit.
- 9. <u>VOTE SECURITIES</u>. Vote at all meetings of stockholders of any corporation and otherwise act as my attorney or proxy in respect of my shares of stock or other securities or investments that now or hereafter belong to me, and appoint substitutes or

proxies with respect to any of those shares of stock.

- 10. EXECUTE TAX RETURNS AND ACT IN TAX MATTERS. Execute on my behalf any tax return and act for me in any examination, audit, hearing, conference or litigation relating to taxes, including authority to file and prosecute refund claims, and enter into any settlements.
- 11. <u>SELL, RENT, LEASE OR EXCHANGE REAL PROPERTY</u>. Sell, rent, lease for any term, or exchange any real property or interests in it for such considerations and upon such terms and conditions as my Attorney-in-Fact may see fit, and execute, acknowledge and deliver all instruments conveying or encumbering title to property owned by me alone as well as any owned by me jointly.
- 12. <u>PROSECUTE</u>, <u>DEFEND AND SETTLE ALL LEGAL PROCEEDINGS</u>. Prosecute, defend and settle all actions or other legal proceedings touching my estate or any part of it or touching any matter in which I may be concerned.
- 13. <u>PURCHASE "FLOWER BONDS"</u>. Purchase bonds issued by the United States that may be applied at face or maturity on account of estate tax liabilities, commonly known as "flower bonds".

14. MAKE GIFTS.

- a. <u>Individuals</u>. My Attorney-in-Fact is authorize to make irrevocable gifts of my assets to one or more of my issue and to the spouse or surviving spouse of any of my issue, or to my Attorney-in-Fact. The total fair market value of my assets which may be given to each individual shall not exceed Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars in any calendar year. This limitation shall not be cumulative from year to year. My Attorney-in-Fact is authorized to make those gifts: outright; to a custodian under the Uniform Gift to Minors Act or the Uniform Transfers to Minors Act of either the State in which the donee or the custodian resides, or any other State of competent jurisdiction; by additions to existing trusts; or otherwise; as my Attorney-in-Fact determines.
- b. <u>Medical Expenses</u>. My Attorney-in-Fact is authorized to pay from my assets any and all expenses for medical care incurred by each individual named or described in Subparagraph (a) of the Paragraph 14. Payment shall be made directly to a person who provides that medical care, and not to any other person. The total fair market value of my assets which may be expended for each individual's medical care shall be unlimited. The term "medical care" has the same meaning as is accorded to it by Section 213(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

- c. Tuition Expenses. My Attorney-in-Fact is authorized to pay from my assets tuition expenses at an educational organization, for the education or training of each individual named or described in Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph 14. Payment shall be made directly to that educational organization, and not to any other person. The total fair market value of my assets which may be expended for each individual's tuition expenses shall be unlimited. The term "educational organization" has the same meaning as is accorded it by Section 170(b)(1)(A)(ii) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.
- d. <u>Limitations</u>. My Attorney-in-Fact shall not exercise any authorization granted in Paragraph 14 in discharge of any legal obligation imposed upon my Attorney-in-Fact.
- 15. <u>REVOCABLE TRUST(S)</u>. Create, amend, modify or revoke any document relating to revocable trust(s). Assign and convey any and all of my property, real or personal, to any trust established by me or by others over which I have unrestricted right of revocation or withdrawal, at such times as my Attorney-in-Fact deems appropriate, and execute and deliver to the trustee appropriate assignments, deeds, and other instruments of conveyance or transfer thereof, even if my Attorney-in-Fact is trustee of such trusts.
- 16. <u>CHANGE BENEFICIARY DESIGNATIONS</u>. Change beneficiary designations for any life insurance policies, Individual Retirement Accounts or employee benefit plans owned by me or established in my name.
- 17. <u>PURCHASE INSURANCE</u>. Insure any of my property, real or personal, in such amounts and on such terms as my Attorney-in-Fact may deem proper.
- 18. EMPLOY AGENTS. Employ and pay reasonable compensation to agents, accountants, attorneys, and investment counsel to assist in the exercise of any of the powers set out herein.
- 19. <u>DISCLAIM</u>. To exercise all rights of renunciation and disclaimer created by or granted under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended and the laws of the State of Florida; to renounce or disclaim, in whole or in part, any right, power, privilege or immunity with respect to property intended to pass to me under any testamentary or nontestamentary instrument.
- 20. <u>NOMINATE GUARDIAN</u>. To nominate to a court of proper jurisdiction any person (including my Attorney-in-Fact) or any institution, to serve as Guardian of my person, estate or both, which Guardian shall be permitted to serve without bond.
- 21. ARRANGE FOR AND CONSENT TO MEDICAL CARE. Arrange for and consent to medical, therapeutical and surgical procedures, including the administration of

drugs.

- 22. <u>WAIVER OF PHYSICIAN-PATIENT OR ATTORNEY-CLIENT PRIVILEGE</u>. My Attorney-in-Fact is authorized to waive any physician-patient or attorney-client privilege which I have.
- 23. ACT WITH HIGH DEGREE OF DISCRETION. - 24. ENFORCE COMPLIANCE. Some persons may attempt to ignore or circumvent the directions of my Attorney-in-Fact. I want to discourage dilatory tactics, spurious defenses, and non-compliance with those directions. I recommend that my Attorney-in Fact warn each banking institution and other person concerned to comply with the provisions of this Power. In an extreme case, I recommend that my Attorney-in-Fact consider instituting an action: to recover the amount of any loss resulting from non-compliance with those directions, the legal costs of implementing those directions, and punitive damages; to obtain a mandatory injunction requiring compliance with the directions of my Attorney-in-Fact by any person; and to obtain any other relief that my Attorney-in-Fact determines to be advisable.

The powers conferred upon my Attorney-in-Fact extend to all of my right, title and interest in real or personal property in which I may have an interest jointly with any other person, whether in an estate by the entirety, joint tenancy or tenancy in common, including all property over which I hold a power of appointment, provided, however, that nothing in this Power shall permit the donee of this Power, if I am married, to mortgage or convey Florida real property characterized as "homestead property" without the joiner of my spouse, my spouse's legal guardian or my spouse's Attorney-in-Fact in line with the exercise of a power of attorney made by my spouse.

I hereby reserve: (1) all rights to do personally any acts that my Attorney-in Fact is hereby authorized to perform; (2) the right to grant similar powers of attorney to others; (3) the right to amend the Power of Attorney in any manner; and (4) the right to revoke the Power in whole or in part.

This Power may be terminated either by me or by my Attorney-in-Fact by either of us giving written notice of such termination to the other. An executed duplicate of this

Power, or a photocopy thereof, delivered by me or by my Attorney-in-Fact to any third party shall be conclusive proof that this Power has not been terminated and this Power shall continue in effect until the third party is advised by written notice from me or my Attorney-in-Fact of a termination of the Power.

This instrument is executed by me in the State of Florida and shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida, but it is my intention that this Power shall be exercisable in any other state or jurisdiction where I may have any property or interests in property.

I hereby confirm all acts of my Attorney-in-Fact pursuant to this Power. I specifically grant my Attorney-in-Fact the authority to record this instrument in the public records of the Florida County within which I reside and in any other jurisdiction where my Attorney-in-Fact in his or her sole discretion believes necessary or appropriate.

Any act that is done under this Power between the revocation of this instrument and notice of that revocation to my Attorney-in-Fact shall be valid unless the persons claiming the benefit of the act had notice of the revocation.

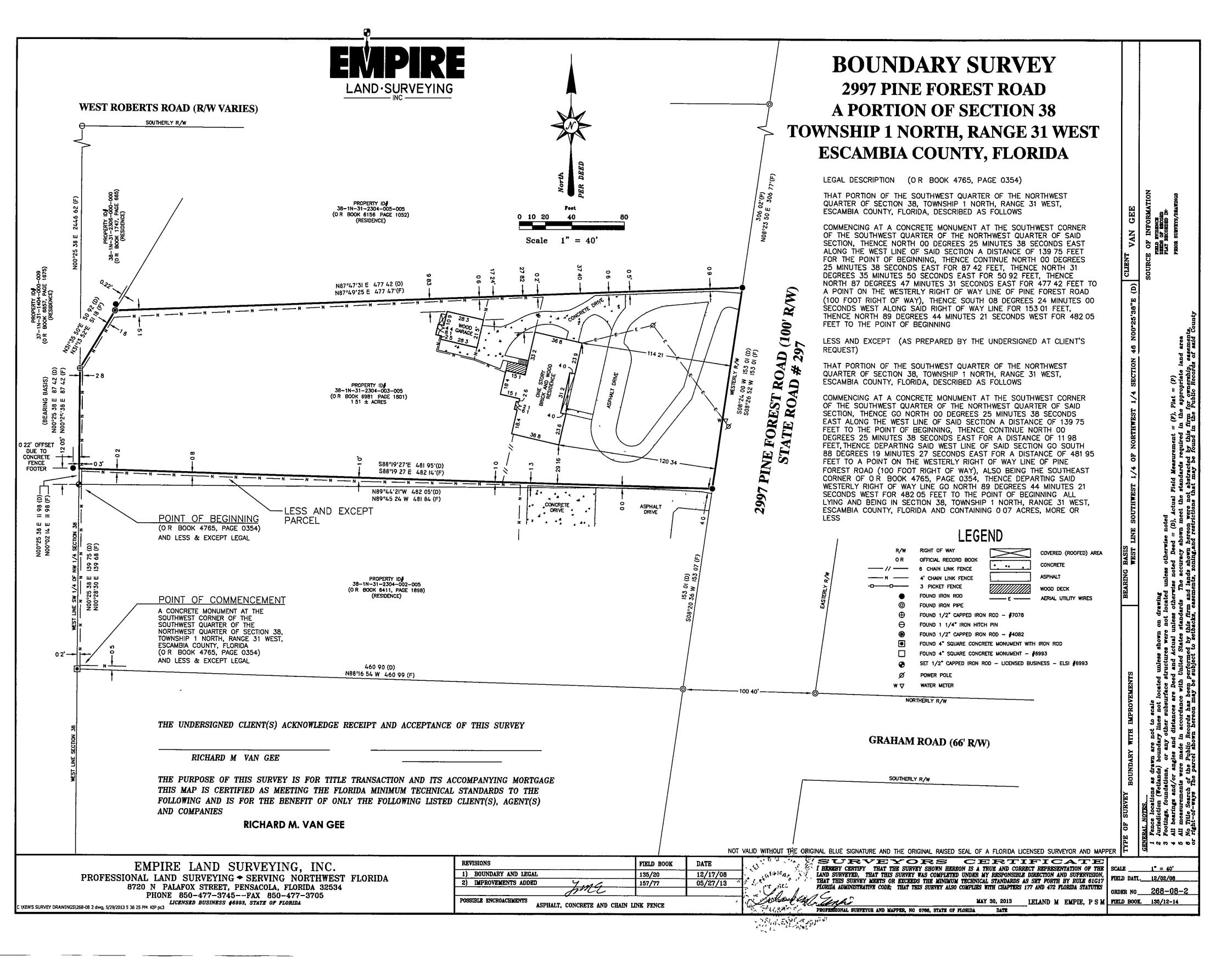

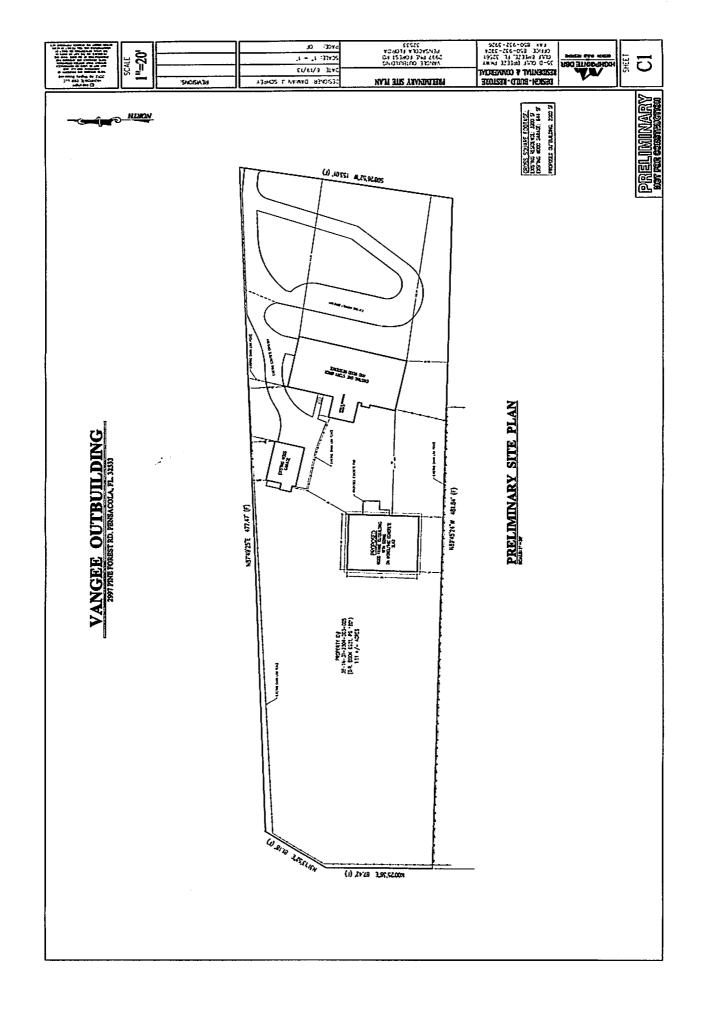
