7. Next Steps

Chairwoman Terry announced that Escambia County is in the process of hiring Dewberry as the consulting firm to develop project selection criteria and the multiyear implementation plan (MYIP). She explained that the Committee and hired firm will draft the first phase of the MYIP which will provide a comprehensive assessment of the condition and needs of Escambia County, and their solutions based on the best available science and public input. Based on this assessment, Dewberry and the RESTORE Advisory Committee will develop project selection criteria. The comprehensive assessment and project selection criteria will likely be submitted to the United States Department of Treasury (Treasury) for review prior to project selection.

Once reviewed, the Committee will rank proposed projects and recommend a final ranked project list and MYIP to the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) for review and approval. Once approved, the MYIP will be submitted to the United States Department of Treasury (Treasury) for approval. Chairwoman Terry noted that she anticipates that the MYIP will be amended, as conditions within Escambia County change over time. Chairwoman Terry explained that Treasury will be responsible for administering funds to Escambia County as a grant program. Once Escambia County receives RESTORE Act funds, selected projects will need to go through the County's procurement process. She explained that this process may benefit applicants by allowing them to submit projects without requiring the applicant to provide staffing.
