a. Library Update - Dr. Bryant

Dr. Bryant stated that the Library Board of Governance was soliciting a design group for the library and it could be on the BCC agenda as early as May 16, 2019.

b. OLF8 Update - Commissioner Bergosh

Commissioner Bergosh reported that Navy Federal Credit Union submitted a revised offer of 96 acres for 4.92 million. Some of the acreage was determined to not be wetlands. It was also reported that Navy Federal will be building athletic fields that will allow for public use. Pavilions and bathrooms are also planned. These amenities are still in the design phase. Commissioner Bergosh reiterated his hope for having 1,000 jobs associated with the old OLF8 property in order to qualify for a Triumph grant. Navy Federal has already pledged 300 additional jobs, plus are funding the master plan for the property.
