Rules & Standards Governing Training Facilities

FAC 69A-37.060


Certification as an approved Firefighter Recruit Training Facility.

NFPA 1403 Standard for Live Fire Training.

FAC 69A-37.060

- 1. Fixed structure not less than two stories.
- 2. Each floor not less than 400 net square feet (exclusive of hallways, stairways, balconies or vestibule areas).
- 3. Masonry, reinforced concrete or other fire resistive material as approved.
- 4. All floors completely enclosed and suitable for smoke training.







Proposed Facility Site With FSFC Overlay






Proposed Facility Site Topographic Map

- 1. Establish an agreement between Escambia County and Ascend.
- 2. Transfer ownership of the property to Escambia County is required.
- 3. Find sources of additional funding. Current budget is \$817,492.10. Early estimates of additional funding needed is \$3,500,000.00-\$3,750,000.00.
- 4. Initiate the RFP process for the hiring of a design and engineering team.







Informational Item









Background Information

- a) Existing operations have <u>90 days</u> from 8/2/11 to apply for an informational permit and <u>12 months</u> from 8/2/11 to apply for a resource extraction permit.
- b) If an existing operation receives an informational permit:
 - 1) It may continue operations until it receives its resource extraction permit, subject to inspection.
 - 2) If it applies for the resource extraction permit by 9/2/11, it will be treated as an <u>existing</u> use.
 - 3) After 9/2/11, it will be treated as a new use.
- c) If an existing operation <u>fails to apply</u> for an informational permit within 90 days of 8/2/11:
 - 1) It cannot apply for an informational permit.
 - 2) It will be considered as an unpermitted code violation until it receives a resource extraction permit.
 - 3) If it applies for a resource extraction permit, it will be treated as a <u>new</u> use.
- d) Requires owners to give County staff the right of inspection in exchange for the informational permit;
