The "Rolled Back Rate" is a computed millage rate that would generate the same amount of ad valorem tax dollars as the prior Fiscal Year, based on the proposed year's tax roll, excluding new construction.

The millage rates tentatively approved by the Board for TRIM notification are 6.6165 for the County-wide millage rate, .3590 for the Library Municipal Services Taxing Unit (MSTU) and .6850 for the Sheriff's Law Enforcement Municipal Services Taxing Unit

(MSTU). The aggregate of these millage rates proposed for Fiscal Year 2018/2019 is 3.17% above the "Rolled Back Rate" certified by the Property Appraiser. This represents the percentage increase in property taxes tentatively adopted by the Board.
